Starting January 1, 2026, this is the **Only** application that will be accepted. So please start to clean out and get rid of old application forms. I would suggest that you start to use these new forms in December so that when you vote on the new members for transmittal in late December or January, they are on the correct application form.

Districts across Arizona are keeping the energy high, with several continuing to raise their membership percentages and helping




push our overall Department total to 92.51%. Fantastic work, everyone—your dedication to recruiting, retaining, and re-engaging members keeps our organization strong!
