




Why We Do What We Do

Navigating the complex landscape of Veterans benefits from federal and state agencies, Veteran Service Organizations and **more than 40,000** military focused charities can be overwhelming.




Only 15% of Veterans strongly agree they received good guidance on benefits and resources when exiting the military.


The MyVetBENEFITS mobile app and website instantly match Veterans, Service Members, and their families to the benefits they've earned.




How it Works

Step 1 – Users submit their profile based on their (or their spouse's) time in service.


91% of users submit a full profile.




Step 2 – The app then creates a personalized list of benefits from the VA, State Veteran Departments, Veteran Service Organizations, and more.






How it Works

Step 3 – A select group of organizations are also provided for users to browse and directly connect with.






User-Friendly Features

Users can narrow down their benefits results even further by using the keyword search, filtering by category, and saving to favorites.






Serving The Entire Military Lifecycle

MyVetBENEFITS serves the entire military lifecycle from entrance to exit and beyond, addressing the needs of military members, Veterans, and their families.




Benefits Matching at Every Level










Key FeaturesBenefits Page


The home page displays the user's matched benefits.



The home page defaults to "Matched" benefits based on the user's profile – **329** results.




"All" displays every benefit in the database, regardless of the user's profile – **2553** results.




"Saved" only displays benefits saved by the user – **2 results**.

Key FeaturesHamburger Menu


The hamburger "Menu" opens a list of features to choose from.






Key FeaturesKeyword Search
