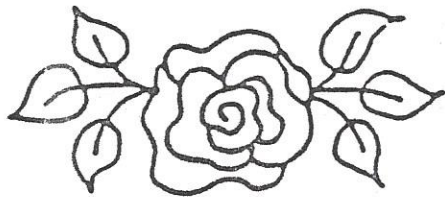

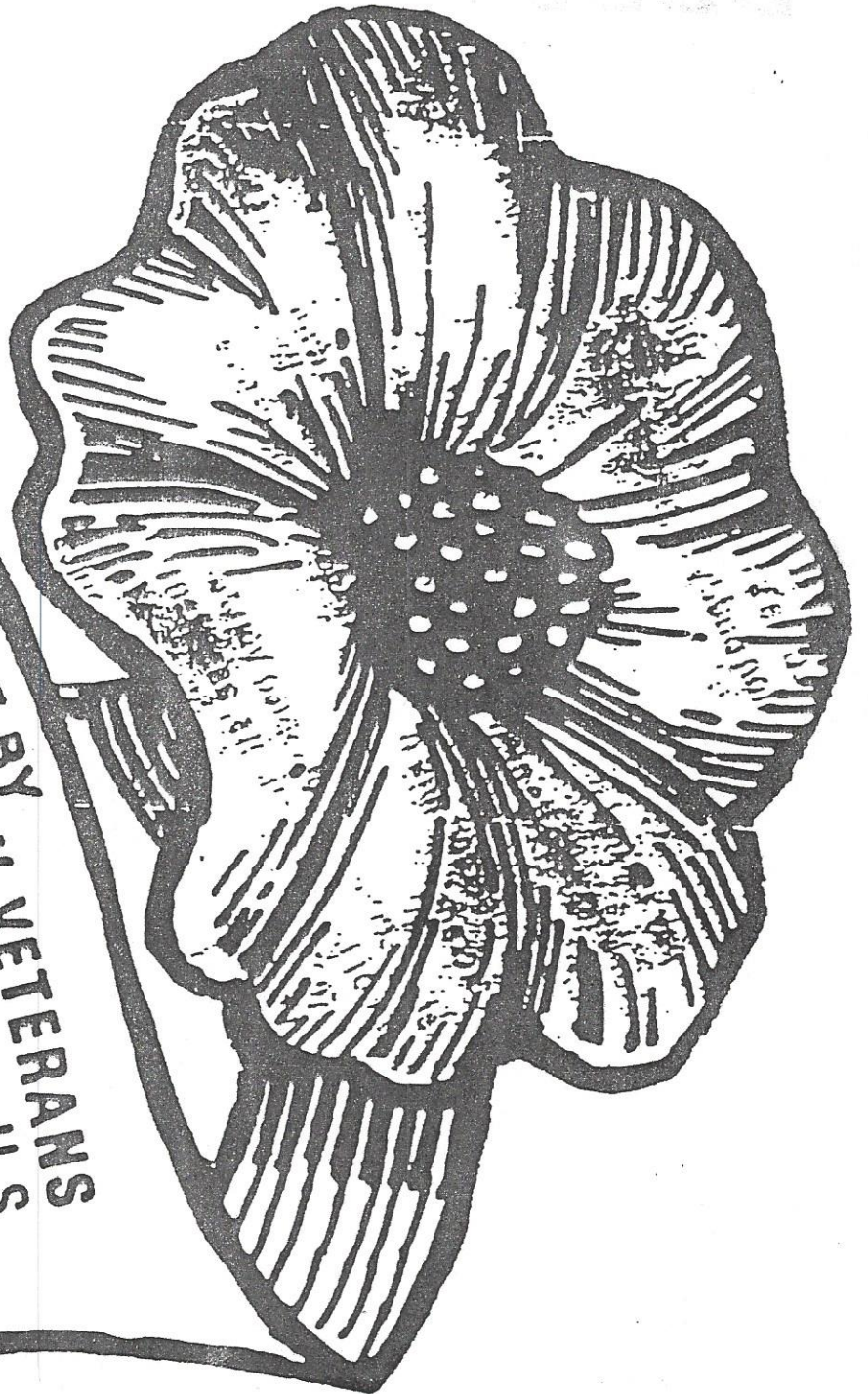

BUDDY POPPY SWEAT SHIRT PATTERN

**DISABLED AND NEEDY VETERANS
For Veterans of Foreign Wars of the U.S.**



BUDDY POPPY CORSAGE
(FALL COLORS)

MATERIALS NEEDED: 110 POPPIES: PINKING SHEARS: GRAY PRIMER SPRAY
PAINT: CAN OF ORANGE, BROWN AND YELLOW "FAST DRYING" ENAMEL SPRAY
PAINT: BABY BREATH, GOLD LEAF, IF AVAILABLE, OR ANY "OAK-LIKE" LEAF,
18" RIBBON AND FLORIST TAPE.

DIRECTIONS: DISMANTLE 110 POPPIES. TAKE 4 POPPIES
TOGETHER.. "PINK" AROUND THE HOLD OF THESE 4 POPPIES STACKED TOGETHER.
TAKE 4 MORE, "PINK" A LITTLE FARTHER OUT. PLACE THESE ON STEM AS
YOU GO. TAKE FOUR MORE, A LITTLE FARTHER OUT... AND KEEP DOING 4
AT A TIME UNTIL YOU HAVE FOUR JUST AROUND THE EDGE OF THE POPPIES.
YOU SHOULD HAVE UP TO 20 ON THE STEM, AND THEY SHOULD LOOK LIKE A
MUM. NOW DO TWO MORE LIKE THIS.

FOR THE LITTLE BUDS, STACK 15-20 TOGETHER. PUT THE STEM IN THE "BACK-
SIDE" OF POPPIES. "PINK" ALL AROUND THESE LITTLE BUDS, FAIRLY CLOSE.
TO CENTER HOLE. MAKE 2 OF THESE.

SPRAYING DIRECTIONS: MAKE SURE ROOM OR GARAGE IS WELL VENTILATED.
LAY BLOOMS AND BUDS ON PAPER, AND SPRAY WITH PRIMER. THEY WILL DRY
QUITE FAST, BUT MAY NEED A SECOND COAT OF PRIMER.. (YELLOW PAINT WILL
NOT "TAKE" UNLESS IT IS ENTIRELY COATED WITH PRIMER.)

REPEAT THE SAME WITH THE PAINT. AGAIN, YOU MAY NEED TWO COATS OF
PAINT, DEPENDING ON YOUR BRAND USED. (PAINT I USE IS FOUND AT LUMBER
OR HARDWARE STORE, BUT YOU MAY USE FABRIC SPRAY PAINT FOUND IN CRAFT
STORES.. MORE EXPENSIVE.)

AFTER YOU HAVE YOUR BUDS AND FLOWERS MADE, SPRAY A LITTLE OF EACH
COLOR PAINT IN A DISH OR JAR LID. USE "Q-TIP" TO PAINT THE CENTER
STEM A DIFFERENT COLOR, AND ALSO TO ETCH IN OTHER SHADING.

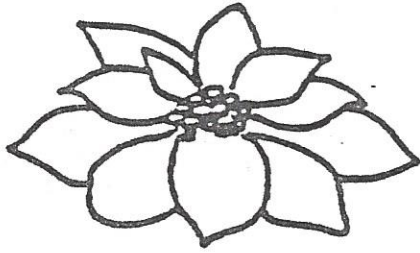
ASSEMBLE BY USING A SINGLE LEAF. PLACE A LITTLE BABY BREATH ON IT.
THEN THREE FLOWERS AND TWO BUDS ON TOP. SMALL BUDS SHOULD BE AT
THE TOP OF CORSAGE. (AT LEAST ONE SHOULD BE). WRAP WITH FLORIST
TAPE. MAKE RIBBON-BOW AND PLACE UNDER FIVE FLOWERS/BUDS. COMPLETELY
WRAP ALL WIRES IN FLORIST TAPE. YOU SHOULD NOW HAVE A BEAUTIFUL
CORSAGE.

A SMALLER CORSAGE OR BOUTONNIERE CAN BE MADE BY USING THREE FLOWERS
AND BUDS. IF USING FOR A MAN, USE ONE FLOWER AND TWO BUDS. BUT
FOR A LADIES CORSAGE, USE TWO FLOWERS AND ONE BUD. THESE WILL TAKE
55-60 POPPIES.

THESE CAN ALSO BE MADE IN VARIOUS COLORS FOR SPRING AND SUMMER, OR
IN THE NATURAL RED FOR CHRISTMAS, HOWEVER, THE FALL COLORS ARE BY
FAR THE MOST STRIKING.

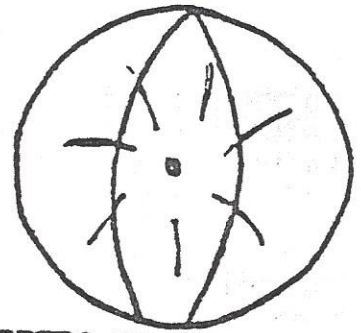

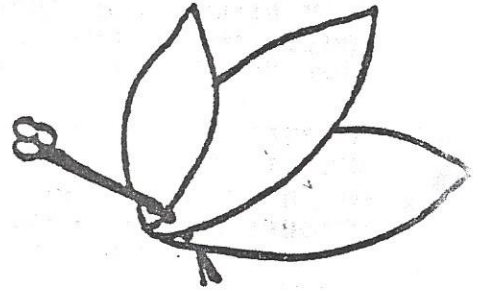
TRIM POPPIES TO FORM PETAL-LIKE LEAVES ON ABOUT 5 OR 6 POPPIES

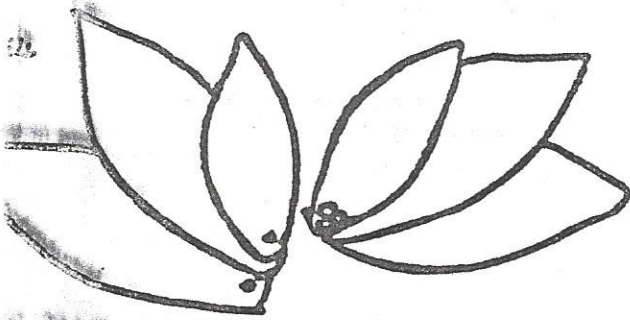


ON THE REST OF THE POPPIES, MAKE SMALLER PETALS TO BE USED FOR OVERLAY.

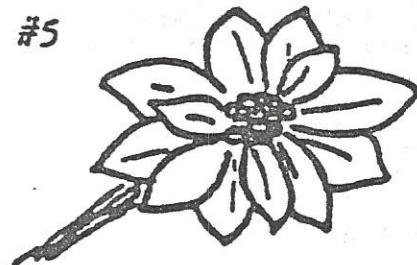


PIERCE LOWER EDGE OF LEAVES. INSERT POPPY CENTERS THROUGH 2 OR 3 LEAVES.



REPEAT PROCESS #3, INSERTING POPPY CENTERS THROUGH ALL OF THE PETALS, UNTIL FULL BLOOM IS ACHIEVED. TWIST CENTER WIRES TOGETHER TO SECURE FLOWER.

YOUR POPPY POINSETTIA IS COMPLETE. USE GOLD ACRYLIC PAINT FOR THE PETALS AND GLITTER FOR THE CENTER OF THE FLOWER.



THE SAME PROCEDURE MAY BE USED TO MAKE HOLLY LEAVES AND BERRIES. SHAPE EACH PETAL LIKE A HOLLY LEAF.

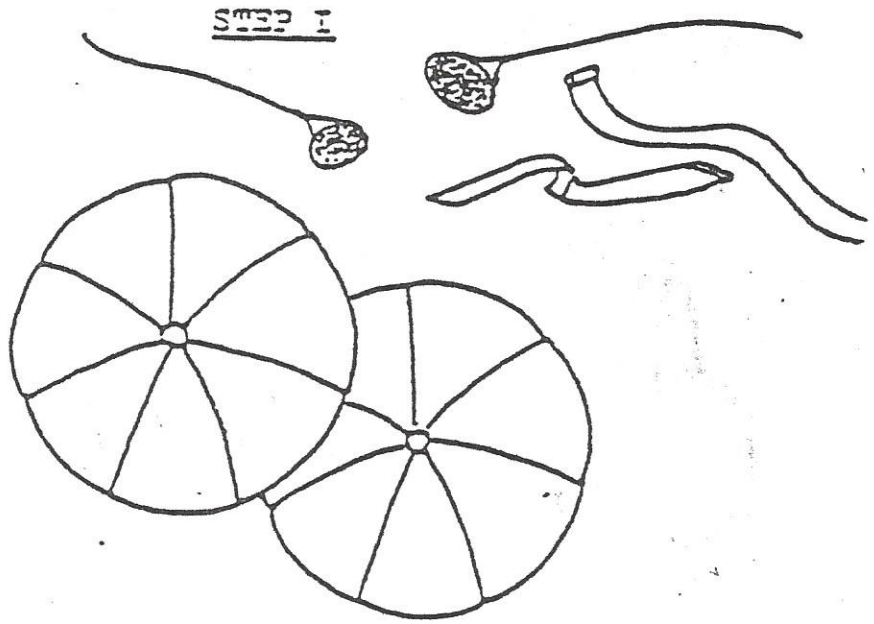

- 2 poppies
- white & yellow paint
(enamel or acrylic)
- floral tape

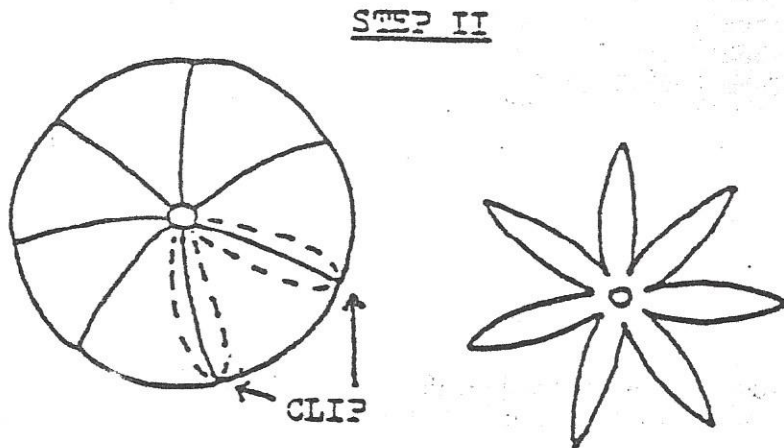
STEP I

Remove poppy centers &
legs.



STEP II

Using natural curve of
poppy as a guideline, clip
poppy toward center to
form petals. Repeat with
second poppy.

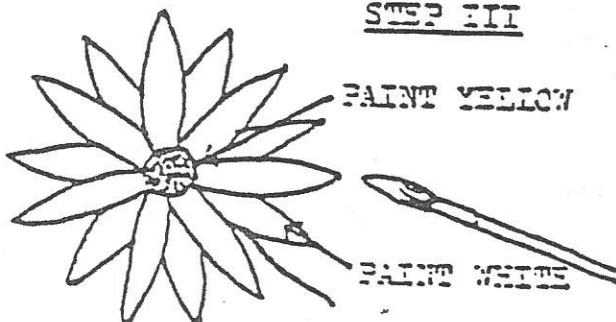


STEP III

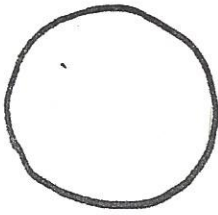
Paint petals white & one center
with yellow paint. Feed painted
center stem back through both
poppies and wrap with floral
tape.

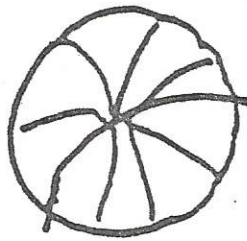

POPPY ROSE II (in more detail)



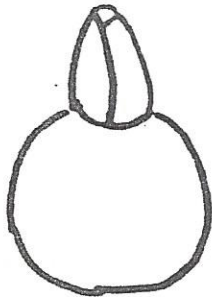
1. Use a form ball, size - 1" or over.



2. Cut poppy in half. Slightly rounded



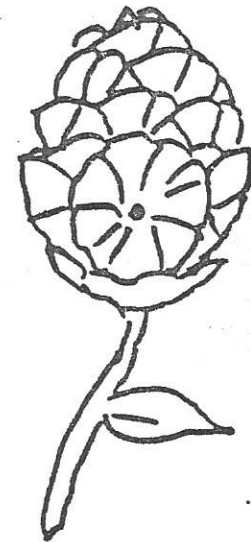
3. With gloss side out, bring points to center to form a cone shape.



4. Place poppy cone on ball, fasten with straight pins. Cone should overlap to form center of rose.



5. Press center of poppy with thumb, attach (gloss side out) to ball with pins. Overlapping each poppy creates the desired flair.



6. Graduate petals may be trimmed for stem placement on bottom if necessary.

Foliage may be purchased at craft stores or cut to the desired shape from poppies and spray painted.

Materials needed for 1 rose--

- 1 styrofoam ball
- 20 or so poppies
- straight pins
- floral wire
- floral tape
- green calyx
- 3 or 4 green leaves

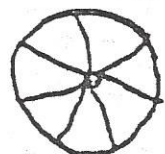
7. Bend a small hook on a floral wire for stem and insert into center of rose. Pull down into rose--slip a calyx on the wire. fasten to rose with straight pins. Start wrapping floral tape around wire and gradually add leaves to the stem and your rose is complete.

 Flexible wire
 Floral tape

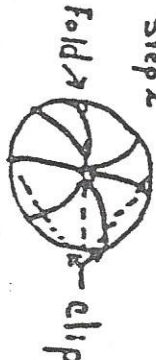

Trim each petal and fold in center to form one rose petal.

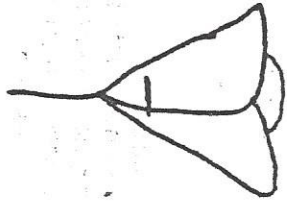
Put 2 popples together to form cone shape. Insert flexible wire in center holes of each poppy. Pull wire through and secure by twisting together. Length of wire will determine length of rose.

Step 3



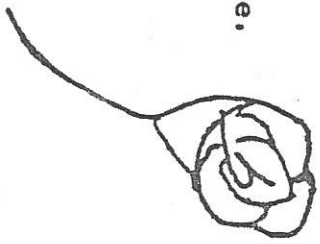
Step V
 Place remaining 2 popples around outer edge of cone, folding each of these 2 petals, to form final petals of rose. Staple just above stem. Bind with floral tape, rose will round out.

Final Stage

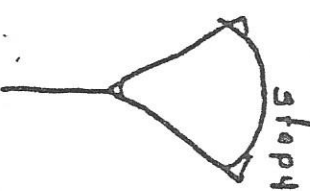
Your Buddy Poppy Rose is complete. Use leares ribbon or other material to further enhance your rose.



Step IV

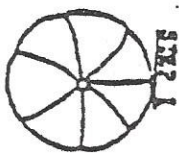
Place 2 open petals, face side in, at sides of rose center now formed.

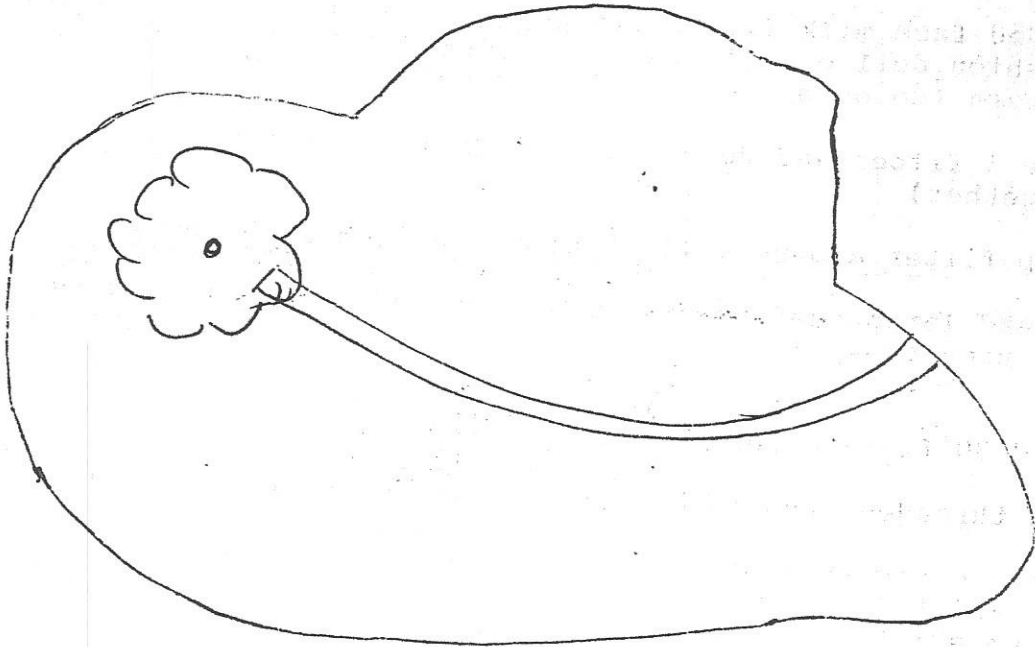


BUDDY POPPY DOLL

Materials

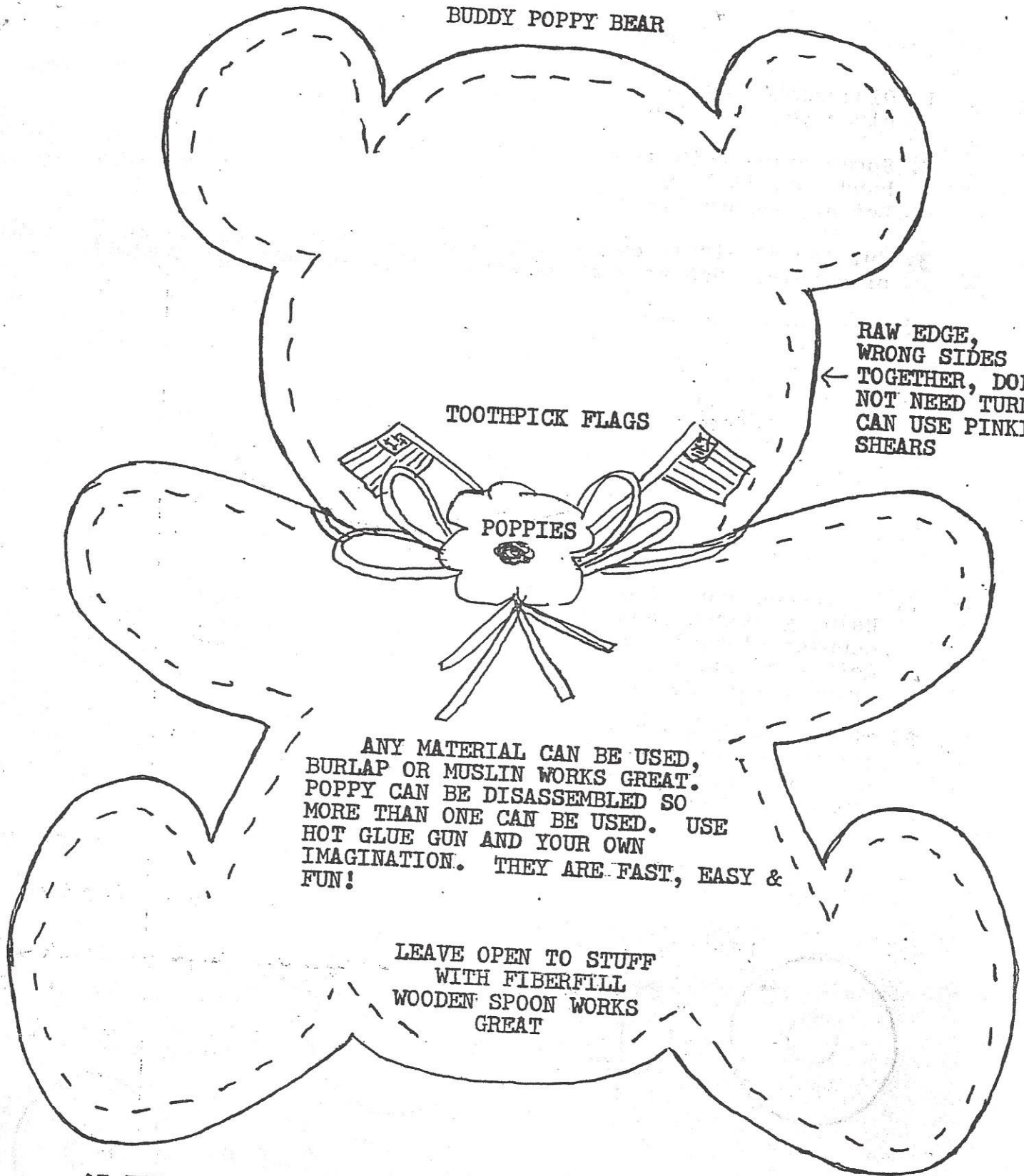
- 6" bonded face milk filters (# depends on size of doll & skirt)
- 11" fashion doll or doll base (larger doll may be used)
- 4 oz. yarn (color or colors of your choice)
- 1--take 1 filter and fold into thirds (for larger doll use two & sew together)
- 2--Wrap filter around doll's torso & stitch with needle and thread
- 3--Thread large-eyed needle with yarn and pierce filter between doll's breasts--pull yarn around neck of doll & tie into bow at back
- 4--fold 30 filters into quarters
- 5--Run threaded needle through top corner of all 30 filters
- 6--Pull needle through & place around waist of doll--tie yarn around waist in knot & cut yarn--gently pull disks around to fill out skirt
- 7--Fold 60 filters in half and pull yarn through center--tie bows on all disks
- 8--Start with one of disks folded in half and separate two sections of skirt--put needle through both the quarter and half sections and tie a bow--continue around until all 60 are connected to skirt
- 9--fold 60 more filters in half & tie bows
- 10--connect these 60 to the first 60 as you did the first time--tying bows on each
- 11--connect middle and lower layers of skirt with bows to remove spaces
- 12--HAT--take 2 filters & fold in half--cut semi-circle out of middle--open disk and stitch around inner circle and outer circle with yarn (leave strings on each side of inner circle to tie finished hat to doll)
- 13--Add poppies wherever you wish

HAT MAGNET



CUT 1 CARDBOARD AND ONE FELT PIECE AND GLUE TOGETHER. MAKE HAT BAND FROM FELT OR YARN AND ATTACH POPPY BY POKING THROUGH TO BACK AND GLUE DOWN STEM. GLUE ON A MAGNET AND YOU HAVE CREATED A MAGNET. YOU CAN ALSO VARY THE SIZE AND MAKE PINS.

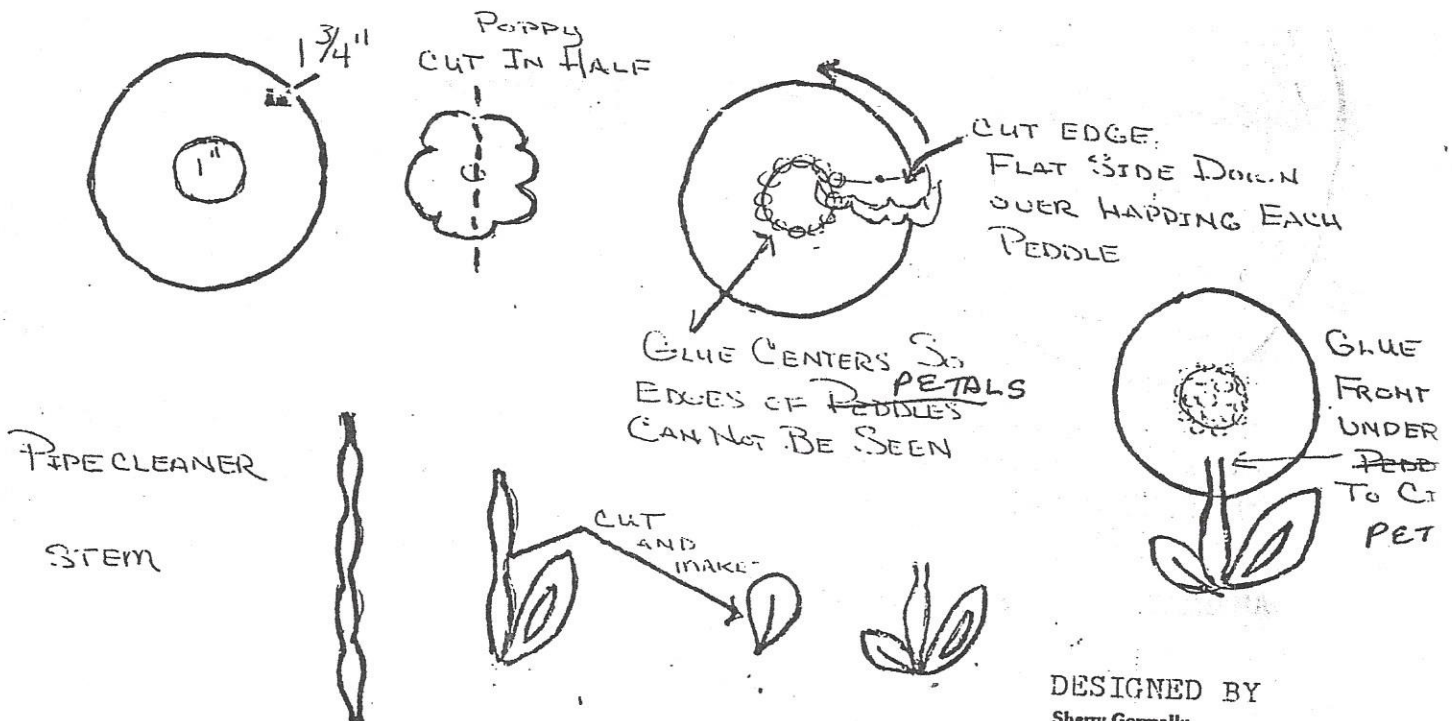

POPPY SUNFLOWER MAGNET

1. Disassemble 20 to 30 poppies. Needed amount will depend on how close you overlap them.
2. Spray paint both sides of poppy with yellow paint. You can paint by hand but, it takes much longer. More than one coat might be needed. Let dry thoroughly between coats.
3. Cut 1-3/4" circle out of posterboard. Draw 1" circle in the middle of circle. Use as a guide when gluing on ~~peddles~~ ^{PETALS}.
4. With poppy centers still attached to stem, paint by hand the centers with acrylic brown paint. Stick into piece of styrofoam to dry.
5. Cut painted poppies in half. Glue on back side along straight edge of poppy and attach to circle. Work counter clockwise overlapping ~~peddles~~ ^{PETALS}. Be sure they are hanging over the outside edge of your circle so the posterboard does not show. (hot glue gun works best)
6. After all ~~peddles~~ ^{PETALS} are glued in place paint center & back yellow ^{PETA} or brown. If you use brown be careful not to get it on the ~~peddles~~.
7. Clip centers off stems with wire cutters. Takes 25-30 centers. Using glue gun, put small amount on bottom of center. Working counter clockwise fill in 1" center putting them as close together as possible. If a little glue shows, touch it up with brown paint. Spray finished flower with clear satin finish.
8. To make stem use One green chenille bump pipecleaner. Shape bottom two bumps into a leaf, securing at bottom with hot glue. clip off top bump, bend in half to make small leaf and glue to back of bottom of stem. Find place under ~~peddles~~ ^{PETALS} that stem will lay flat against circle. Remove, saving spot, glue with hot glue and return.
9. Cut two 1" strips of magnetic tape, glue on back side of finished sunflower.
