Voice of Democracy- Grades 9, 10, 11, 12 recorded oral essay, 3 to 5 minutes

Theme- "Why Is The Veteran Important?"

Patriot's Pen- Grades 6, 7, 8 written essay 300-400 words

Theme- "My Pledge to our Veterans"

Young American Creative Patriotic Arts Contest- open to grades 9, 10, 11, 12- 2-dimensional art on paper or canvas. National first place winner \$15,000. Original art and **completed** application are due to the local VFW Auxiliary by March 31, 2023.

New Contest

3-Dimensional Creative Patriotic Art-This is an entry that can be Papier-mâché, pottery, sculpture, fabric, wood, metalwork, etc. open again to $9^{th} - 12^{th}$ grade students. First place winner receives \$2500.00 from National. Due to the local VFW Auxiliary also by March 31^{st} , 2023.

VFW Auxiliary National Continuing Education Grant- Four \$1000.00 Grants, one per conference. Open to any Auxiliary member of at least one year and 18 years of age. 300 word essay and completed application sent to National Headquarters by February 15th,2023.

We still have the Young American Patriotic Art Escrow Fund if anyone wants to help increase the number of scholarships and the amounts of the awards.

Dept. of Arizona VFW Auxiliary Educational Grant- One \$1000.00 Grant awarded to an Arizona Auxiliary member 18 years of age or older wishing to further their educational goals. Due to Dept. of Arizona Scholarship Chairman by April 1, 2023.

Dept. of Arizona VFW Auxiliary Merit Scholarship- open to high school Seniors graduating in 2023- son, daughter, sister, brother, grandson, granddaughter of an Arizona VFW or VFW Auxiliary member or Auxiliary member themselves. Due to Dept. of Arizona Scholarship Chairman by April 1, 2023.
